

Bill No. 82 of 1954

A BILL TO AMEND THE BILLS OF SALE ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Bills of Sale Act*, being chapter 217 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 32 is amended. Subsection (4) is replaced by a new subsection (4). The introduction of the five-day week made this amendment necessary in order to enable the bringing of the hours of the offices of registration clerks into line with similar amendments to other Acts. Subsection (5) is removed.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Bills of Sale Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Bills of Sale Act*, being chapter 217 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 32 is amended by striking out subsections (4) and (5) and by substituting the following: Section 32 amended

“(4) A bill of sale may be registered only during the hours that the office of the registration clerk is kept open.”.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
