A BILL TO AMEND THE ALBERTA MUNICIPAL ASSESSMENT COMMISSION ACT

Note

This Bill amends The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act, being chapter 156 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 4b, subsections (1) and (2) are amended. These amendments are to provide for the absorption by the Department of Municipal Affairs of fifty per cent of the cost of all assessments made by departmental assessors in towns and villages. Previously only twenty-five per cent of the cost of a general or annual assessment of lands, buildings and improvements was absorbed by the Department when their assessors made such assessments.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act, being chapter 156 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 4b is amended

Section 4b amended

- (a) as to subsection (1) by striking out the words "each general or annual assessment of lands, buildings and improvements" and by substituting the words "the assessment",
- (b) as to subsection (2)
 - (i) by striking out the words "Twenty-five' and by substituting the word "Fifty",
 - (ii) by striking out the words "seventy-five" and by substituting the word "fifty".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is coming into force assented to.
