## Bill No. 100 of 1954

### A BILL TO AMEND THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ACT

#### Note

This Bill amends *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 54 is amended. Subsection (1) is amended to extend the sessional indemnity payable to members of the Legislative Assembly from two thousand dollars to two thousand four hundred dollars and to extend the allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of their duties from one thousand dollars to one thousand two hundred dollars. Subsection (5) is added to make reference to the allowance payable to the recognized leader of the opposition in the Legislature.

 $\mathbf{H}^{\text{ER}}$  MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Legislative Assembly Act, being chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

**2.** Section 54 is amended

Section 54 amended

- (a) as to subsection (1)
  - (i) by adding immediately after the words "two thousand" the words "four hundred";
  - (ii) by adding immediately after the words "one thousand" the words "two hundred";
- (b) by adding immediately after subsection (4) the following new subsection:

"(5) In each year there shall be paid to the Allowances recognized leader of Her Majesty's loyal opposition of such allowances as may be voted by the Legislative Assembly.".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it  $\frac{Coming into}{force}$  is assented to.
