A BILL TO REPEAL THE UNIT OPERATION OF
MINERAL RESOURCES ACT

NOTE

This Bill repeals *The Unit Operation of Mineral Resources Act*, being chapter 69 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

The Bill to amend *The Mines and Minerals Act* adds certain provisions regarding unit operations and at the same time the provisions of the subject Act are incorporated in *The Mines and Minerals Act*.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.
