- 1. The Hospitalization of City Residents Act, being chapter 29 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950 is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 3, subsection (1), clause (c) is amended by Section 3 striking out the word "eight" and by substituting the word "ten".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it $\frac{\text{Coming into}}{\text{force}}$ is assented to.
