A new section 24 is added which provides for the expiration of this Act on March 31st, 1955, and further empowers the Rental Control Board to decontrol accommodation during the intervening period.

An Act to amend The Rental Control Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Rental Control Act, being chapter 61 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950, is hereby amended.
- 2. The following new section is added immediately after New section 23:
- "24. (1) This Act expires on the 31st day of March, Expiration 1955.
- "(2) At any time before the expiration of this Act the Decontrol Board in its discretion may decontrol any accommodation and thereafter the accommodation so decontrolled ceases to be subject to the provisions of this Act.".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is Coming assented to.
