Bill No. 116 of 1954

A BILL TO PROVIDE THE AUTHORITY AND MEANS TO ENSURE THE ORDERLY DEVELOPMENT OF THAT AREA OF THE PROVINCE KNOWN AS DRAYTON VALLEY

Note

This Bill enacts a new Act entitled "The Drayton Valley Townsite Act".

A new townsite is proposed for the Drayton Valley area as a result of recent developments in the Pembina oil fields. In order to ensure the orderly development of this new townsite, this Bill is being enacted.

The Bill provides that no subdivision of lands shall be approved in the proposed site area unless the landowners contract with the Minister of Municipal Affairs in regard to the development of lots and other matters in the townsite area. The effect of the contract would be to control at the source the initial development of the townsite area.

This Bill comes into force upon assent and is retroactive to the 1st day of March, 1954.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as "The Drayton Valley Townsite Act".

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,

8. (1) The Registrar of the North Alberta Land Regis-Registrar's tration District shall on behalf of the Minister register a caveat Registrar's caveat against the lands to which an agreement made under this Act relates and a copy of the agreement shall be attached to the Registrar's caveat.

(2) The Registrar's caveat may be withdrawn or discharged in whole or in part upon an order of the Minister.
