A BILL TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN THE  
REHABILITATION OF COAL MINERS

NOTE

This Bill enacts a new Act to be known as "*The Coal Miners Rehabilitation Act.*"

It provides authority for the Lieutenant Governor in Council to authorize the expenditure of a sum not exceeding \$100,000.00 toward the rehabilitation of coal miners.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

# BILL

No. 122 of 1954

An Act to provide Assistance in the Rehabilitation of Coal Miners.

(Assented to , 1954)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Coal Miners Rehabil-* Short title  
*itation Act*".

**2.** (1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may author- Rehabil-  
ize the Provincial Treasurer to expend moneys for any itation  
purpose that will assist in the rehabilitation of coal miners  
who have become unemployed in areas designated by the  
Lieutenant Governor in Council.

(2) Amounts expended under this Act shall not exceed  
in the aggregate the sum of one hundred thousand dollars.

**3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it Coming into  
is assented to. force
