An Act to Incorporate the Fathers of the Salesian
Society of Alberta

(Assented to _____, 1955)

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have petitioned Preamble
for an Act constituting them a body politic and corp-
orate with the powers and for the purposes hereinafter set
forth;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the
said petition;

Therefore, Her Majesty by and with the advice and con-
sent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. Joseph Balazskovi, in religion Father Joseph; Louis Incorporation
Masoero, in religion Father Louis; Ralph Simeone, in re-
ligion Father Ralph; Paul Maniscalco, in religion Father
Paul; all of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of
Alberta, and such other persons as are now or may here-
after become under the provisions of this Act members of
the said Association shall be and are hereby declared to
be a body politic and corporate in deed and in name by the
name of "The Salesian Society of Alberta" for the purposes
and objects hereinafter set out.

2. The said corporation shall have the power to acquire, Powers of corporation
erect, conduct, manage and carry on schools, seminaries,
churches and institutions of learning, and boys' homes and
to acquire, purchase, lease, receive and take by gift or
devise under wills or otherwise and to maintain in con-
nection therewith lands, farms and buildings for any pur-
poses thereof.

3. The said corporation shall have perpetual succession Contracts
and a common seal, and may at all times hereafter contract
and be contracted with, including the borrowing of money
or mortgage, or promissory note, sue and be sued, implead
and be impleaded in any matter whatsoever in the Province.

4. The said Corporation is hereby authorized and em- Additional powers
powered:

- (a) to acquire by gift, purchase, devise, bequest, trans-
fer or otherwise real or personal property of every
nature in the Province of Alberta and to have,
hold, possess, enjoy and take and receive the same

for the general uses and purposes, ecclesiastical, religious, charitable, educational and recreational of the said corporation or any part thereof;

- (b) to borrow, raise or secure the payment of money for any of the purposes of the corporation in such manner as shall be deemed expedient and in particular by negotiable instruments and by issue of debentures or debenture stock, bonds, mortgages or obligations charged upon all or any of the property of the corporation, and to purchase, redeem or pay off any such securities in whole or in part;
- (c) to give, sell, exchange, convey, transfer, assign, mortgage, encumber, demise, or otherwise dispose of all or any of the property, real or personal, of the said corporation or any interest therein;
- (d) to make loans and to receive mortgages, bonds and debentures, negotiable instruments or other securities as security therefor; and to assign, sell, transfer, hypothecate, pledge or otherwise dispose of such mortgages or securities so received; and to discharge and release mortgages or other securities so given, either in whole or in part and to extend the period for payment thereof;
- (e) to give any guarantee for payment of any loan, mortgage, bond or debenture issue, obligations or securities made or issued for the purpose of carrying on or expanding the work of the corporation;
- (f) enact such rules, orders and regulations as are deemed necessary for the government and proper administration of the property, affairs and interest of the said corporation, and to repeal and amend the same from time to time, including the enforcement of discipline and the admission and retirement of members, the appointment, deposition or removal of any persons as members of the corporation, or bearing office therein and generally for the internal government of affairs of the said corporation.

Application
of revenue

5. The revenues, assets and profits of all property held by the corporation shall be appropriated and applied to the maintenance of the members of the corporation and of the institutions carried on by the corporation and the construction and repair of buildings and the acquisition of property requisite for the purposes of the corporation and for the advancement of charity and benevolence.

Head
office

6. The head office of the corporation shall be at the City of Edmonton in the Province of Alberta, or at such other place in the Province as may from time to time be determined by the by-laws of the corporation.

Branches

7. The corporation may from time to time have or establish or maintain any number of branches thereof to promote the objects of the corporation and for such pur-

poses may appoint such subordinate officers with such powers and tenure of office as the corporation may deem advisable.

8. Until otherwise directed by by-laws the incorporators mentioned herein shall be the officers of the said corporation and the present existing rules and regulations of the Salesian Society shall, *mutatis mutandis*, be the rules and regulations of the said corporation until changed by by-laws.

Officers

9. The corporation shall at all times when called upon so to do by the Lieutenant Governor in Council render an account in writing of its property and affairs.

Accounting

10. The powers herein granted shall be subject to the general laws of the Province now in force or hereafter enacted.

Powers subject to general laws

11. The said corporation shall be responsible for the rental and finance of its own medical and hospitalization scheme and shall be liable to indemnify the Municipal District of Sturgeon River, the City of Edmonton and the Municipal District of Lac Ste. Anne from any hospitalization or medical expenditure incurred by it in respect of any member of the Salesian Society or of any person on the staff of the said institution.

Medical and hospitalization scheme

12. All the real and personal property hereinafter described shall be exempt from taxation as set out herein, namely:

Exemption from taxation

- (a) the land located in the Municipal District of Sturgeon River No. 90, not exceeding 5 acres in extent, together with the buildings, equipment and furnishings, and consisting of a portion of Block X, Subdivision Plan 3551 A.E. being a subdivision of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ 26-53-24-w4 M. in the Province of Alberta, so long as the same are exclusively used for educational purposes, except for local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals;
- (b) the land located in the Municipal District of Lac Ste. Anne, not exceeding 4.51 acres in extent, together with the buildings, equipment and furnishings thereon, being used exclusively as a summer school and residence for boys under the care of the Salesian Society, and consisting of:
 - Lots One (1) and Two (2), Gunn Beach, being part of Lot Five (5), Lac Ste. Anne Settlement, in the Province of Alberta, as shown on Subdivision Plan 2393 A.S. and Lots Six (6) to Thirteen (13) inclusive, Block Two (2), in Ste. Anne Beach, in the Lac Ste. Anne Settlement, in the Province of Alberta, as shown on Plan 6866 A.R. and that portion of 2nd Street East in Lac Ste. Anne Beach, directly abutting the said Lot Six (6) to Thirteen (13) as aforesaid;

so long as the same shall be used for the purposes aforesaid, except the local improvement taxes and taxes pertaining to minerals.

Coming into force **13.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
