Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, Preamble John J. Bowlen, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively, the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-four; the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-five; and the Thirtyfirst day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-six, and for other purposes relating thereto;

May it therefore please Your Majesty, that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, Short title 1955".
- 2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may Appropriabe paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, Two tion for 1953-54 Hundred and Twelve Thousand, Ninety-six Dollars and Forty-one Cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-three, to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-four, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may Appropriabe paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, tion for 1954-1955 Eleven Million, Five Hundred and Nine Thousand, Six Hundred and Eighty-two Dollars and Seventy Cents, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-four, to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-five, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

Appropriation for 1955-1956

4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole, Two Hundred and One Million, Nine Hundred and Twenty-nine Thousand and Seventy-two Dollars, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the First day of April, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty-five, to the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Fifty are not otherwise manifely for and set Hundred and Fifty-six, not otherwise provided for, and set forth in Schedule C to this Act.
