

Bill No. 13 of 1955

A BILL TO AMEND THE SUPPLEMENTARY
ALLOWANCES ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Supplementary Allowances Act*, being chapter 89 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952.

This Act is amended by deleting from section 3, subsection (2) the present provision that to be eligible for an allowance under the Act a person must have been resident in the Province for the greater part of the three years immediately preceding the grant of an old age pension, old age assistance, or a blind person's allowance, and by providing that he must satisfy such residence requirements as may be prescribed by regulations.

Chapter 101 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1954, which came into force on June 1st, 1954, increased the maximum amount of the supplementary allowance from ten to fifteen dollars per month. As it has been found desirable to make the increase effective from April 1st, 1954, and an order in council has been passed to make the increase effective from that date, subject to ratification by the Legislature, section 3 of this Bill gives Legislative approval to the change.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of April, 1955.

An Act to amend The Supplementary Allowances Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Supplementary Allowances Act*, being chapter 89 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3, subsection (2) is amended

(a) as to clause (b) by adding immediately after the word "such" the words "residence requirements and";

(b) by striking out clause (c);

(c) by relettering the present clause (d) as clause (c).

3. Section 5, clause (a) is amended by adding immediately after the words "prescribing the" the words "residence requirements and".

4. (1) Chapter 101 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1954, shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of April, 1954.

(2) Order in Council numbered 772-54 of the 26th day of May, 1954, is hereby ratified and validated insofar as that order in council provides for the payment on and after the first day of April, 1954, of a maximum supplementary allowance of fifteen dollars per month to recipients of supplementary allowances.

5. This Act comes into force on the first day of April, 1955.
