

Bill No. 18 of 1955

A BILL TO AMEND THE IRRIGATION DISTRICTS ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Irrigation Districts Act*, being chapter 98 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

A new subsection is being added to section 171 to make it clear that once land has been acquired by an irrigation district for non-payment of irrigation rates, a municipality may not proceed to enforce a sale of the land under *The Tax Recovery Act* to recover arrears of taxes owing to the municipality.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Irrigation Districts Act

(Assented to _____, 1955)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Irrigation Districts Act*, being chapter 98 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 171 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (9) the following new subsection: Section 171 amended

“(10) Where, pursuant to this section, land vests in the board or a purchaser’s agreement for sale is cancelled and all other encumbrances are discharged, *The Tax Recovery Act* does not apply to the land from the time of such vesting or cancellation until the land

“(a) ceases to be vested in the board or in a trustee for Her Majesty to whom the land is transferred by the board,

“(b) is disposed of by the board under an agreement for sale, or

“(c) is leased by the board otherwise than under subsection (6).”.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
