

Bill No. 26 of 1955

A BILL RESPECTING ARREARS OF TAXES UNDER  
THE REPEALED THE EDUCATIONAL TAX ACT

---

NOTE

This Bill enacts an Act to be known as "*The Educational Tax Arrears Act*".

By chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1954, *The Educational Tax Act* was repealed. At the time of repeal no provision was made for the disposition of any arrears of taxes under that Act.

When and if collected, the arrears are to form part of the general revenue of the municipality collecting them.

This Bill is retroactive to April 8th, 1954, the date of the repealing Act.

# BILL

No. 26 of 1955

An Act respecting Arrears of Taxes under the repealed  
The Educational Tax Act

(Assented to , 1955)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,  
enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Educational Tax* Short title  
*Arrears Act*".

2. Notwithstanding its repeal, *The Educational Tax Act* Collection  
shall be deemed to be and continues to be in force for the of arrears  
collection of any arrears of taxes levied thereunder before of taxes  
the first day of January, 1954.

3. Any arrears of taxes collected on or after the first day Disposition  
of January, 1954, shall be retained by and shall form part of of collections  
the general revenue of the municipal district, special area,  
county or improvement district that levied and collected  
the tax.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is Coming into  
assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed force  
to have been in force at all times on and after the eighth  
day of April, 1954.
