

Bill No. 71 of 1955

A BILL TO AMEND THE DISABLED PERSONS'
PENSIONS ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act*, being chapter 33 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1953.

Section 3, clause (a) is amended. The effect of this amendment is to permit the payment of the pension authorized by this Act to a person who is disabled and eighteen years of age or over. Previously, the pension could be paid only if the disabled person were twenty-one or over.

Section 4a, which authorizes agreements re disability pensions being made with the Government of Canada is repealed, as the provision is no longer required in this Act.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act*, being chapter 33 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1953, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3, clause (a), subclause (i) is amended by striking out the words "twenty-one" and by substituting the word "eighteen". Section 3
