Bill No. 72 of 1955

A BILL TO AMEND THE MAGISTRATES AND JUSTICES ACT

Note

Firstly, this Bill amends The Magistrates and Justices Act, being chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

Section 2 is amended by the addition of a new subsection (10). The *Criminal Code* as revised and enacted by chapter 51 of the Statutes of Canada, 1953-54, will come into force on the 1st day of April, 1955. Part XVI of the Code confers certain jurisdiction upon a magistrate who is "specially authorized by the terms of his appointment to exercise the jurisdiction conferred upon a magistrate by this Part" (Part XVI). Subsection (10) empowers the Lieutenant Governor in Council, in the future appointment of a magistrate under the Act, to authorize the exercise of this jurisdiction.

Secondly, the Bill provides that in the case of a magistrate already appointed, it is, with effect from the 1st day of April, 1955, a term of his appointment that he may exercise the jurisdiction conferred upon a magistrate by Part XVI of the Code.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

An Act to amend The Magistrates and Justices Act

(Assented to , 1955)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Magistrates and Justices Act, being chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended by adding immediately after section 2 subsection (9) the following new subsection:

"(10) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may by the terms of appointment, authorize a magistrate to exercise the jurisdiction conferred upon a magistrate by Part XVI of the *Criminal Code*, being chapter 51 of the Statutes of Canada, 1953-54.".

3. (1) It is a term of the appointment of every $T_{erm of}$ magistrate appointed before the first day of April, 1955, appointment that he may exercise the jurisdiction conferred upon a magistrate by Part XVI of the *Criminal Code*, being chapter 51 of the Statutes of Canada, 1953-54.

(2) Subsection (1) is applicable on and after the first day of April, 1955.

4. This Act comes into force on the first day of April, Coming into 1955.
