A BILL TO AMEND THE CULTURAL  
DEVELOPMENT ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Cultural Development Act*, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946.

Section 8, which authorizes the Lieutenant Governor in Council on the recommendation of a cultural development board only to make grants towards the development of library facilities in the Province, is being replaced by a new section containing authority to make grants for any purpose that will assist or encourage cultural development.

This Bill comes into force upon assent.

# BILL

No. 90 of 1955

An Act to amend The Cultural Development Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1955)

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Cultural Development Act*, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1946, is hereby amended.

2. Section 8 is struck out and the following is substituted: Section 8 amended

“8. The Lieutenant Governor in Council is hereby declared to be authorized to make on the recommendation of the Minister grants, scholarships or contributions out of any moneys appropriated for the purpose by the Legislature, or, in the absence of such appropriation, out of the General Revenue Fund, for any purpose that will encourage or assist the cultural development of the Province, or of any person or class of persons within the Province.” Grants, etc., for cultural developments

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
