An Act to amend The Mothers' Allowance Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

PART I

- 1. The Mothers' Allowance Act, being chapter 302 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (2) the following new subsection:
- "(3) A person is not eligible for an allowance under this Act who is, for the purpose of health and welfare services, the responsibility of the Government of Canada.".

PART II

- 3. The Mothers' Allowance Act, being chapter 208 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- **4.** Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (3) the following new subsection:
- "(4) A person is not eligible for an allowance under this Act who is, for the purpose of health and welfare services, the responsibility of the Government of Canada.".
- **5.** Part I and this section come into force on the day this Act is assented to, and Part II, except this section, comes into force and Part I is repealed on the day the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
