**2.** This amendment is similar to provisions now in both The Widows' Pensions Act and The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act and is self-explanatory.

# BILL

No. 4 of 1956

An Act to amend The Mothers' Allowance Act

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1956)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

## PART I

1. *The Mothers' Allowance Act*, being chapter 302 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (2) the following new subsection:

"(3) A person is not eligible for an allowance under this Act who is, for the purpose of health and welfare services, the responsibility of the Government of Canada."

## PART II

3. *The Mothers' Allowance Act*, being chapter 208 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

4. Section 4 is amended by adding immediately after subsection (3) the following new subsection:

"(4) A person is not eligible for an allowance under this Act who is, for the purpose of health and welfare services, the responsibility of the Government of Canada."

5. Part I and this section come into force on the day this Act is assented to, and Part II, except this section, comes into force and Part I is repealed on the day the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
