HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

PART I

- 1. The Improvement Districts Act, 1947, being chapter 9 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1947, is hereby amended.
- 2. The following section is added immediately after section 53:
- "53a. (1) The Minister may in any district appoint an advisory committee of one or more persons.
- "(2) The members of the advisory committee may be paid such remuneration and expenses as may be determined by the Minister.".

PART II

- 3. The Improvement Districts Act, being chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- 4. The following section is added immediately after section 54:
- "54a. (1) The Minister may in any district appoint an advisory committee of one or more persons.
- "(2) The members of the advisory committee may be paid such remuneration and expenses as may be determined by the Minister.".
- 5. Part I and this section come into force on the day this Act is assented to, and Part II, except this section, comes into force and Part I is repealed on the day the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
