### Explanatory Note

The Temporary Restriction on Alienation of Mines and Minerals Act, being chapter 67 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1955, will by its terms expire on the 1st day of July, 1956. This Bill would extend the expiration date for one year so that the said Act will expire on July 1, 1957, instead.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- **1.** The Temporary Restriction on Alienation of Mines and Minerals Act, being chapter 67 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby continued in force until the first day of July, 1957, upon which date the said Act shall expire.
  - 2. Section 5 of the said Act is repealed.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
