Explanatory Note

- 2. Permitting rural mutual telephone companies to enter into contracts with companies other than the Alberta Government Telephones. Section 7, clause (a) presently reads:
 - "7. A company shall have the power to enter into agreements
 "(a) with the Alberta Government Telephones for any purpose which
 is related to or incidental to the purposes for which the company is incorporated;".

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

PART I

- 1. The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act, being chapter 199 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 7, clause (a) is amended by adding immediately after the word "Telephones" the words "or any other person".

PART II

- 3. The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act, being chapter 292 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is amended as to section 8, clause (a) by adding immediately after the word "Telephones" the words "or any other person".
- 4. Part I and this section come into force on the day this Act is assented to, and Part II, except this section, comes into force and Part I is repealed on the day the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
