A Bill to amend The Calgary and Southwestern Railway Company Act

(Private Bill)

Explanatory Notes

Section 13 presently reads:

"13. That the construction of the railway hereby authorized shall be commenced within five years, and shall be completed within ten years from the thirty-first day of March, 1951, and section 70 of The Railway Act, being chapter 197 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, shall not apply to the said Company."

Section 70 of The Railway Act reads:

ection 70 of The Railway Act reads: "70. If the railway authorized by the special Act to be constructed is of a length not greater than thirty miles the company shall construct and put the same in operation within two years from the date of its incorporation; if however the railway is of greater length than thirty miles the company shall in addition to the thirty miles which it is hereby required to construct and put in operation within two years from its date of incorporation, construct and put in operation at least thirty miles during each year immediately following the expiration of the said two years and shall complete the whole railway within five years from the date of incorporation and should the company fail to comply with the provisions of this section then the power granted by the special Act or by this Act shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the railway as then remains uncompleted."

An Act to amend The Calgary and Southwestern Railway Company Act

WHEREAS the Calgary and Southwestern Railway Preamble Company has presented a petition praying for the amendment as hereinafter set forth of *The Calgary and Southwestern Railway Company Act*, being chapter 57 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1918, as amended, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Calgary and Southwestern Railway Company Act, being chapter 57 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1918, is hereby amended.

2. Section 13 as amended is struck out and the following Section 13 is substituted therefor:

"13. The construction of the railway hereby authorized shall be commenced within five years, and shall be completed within ten years from the thirty-first day of March, 1956, and section 70 of *The Railway Act* does not apply to the said Company.".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is Coming assented to.
