Preamble

WHEREAS there exists an Association known as The Mennonite Conference of Alberta, incorporated under *The Religious Societies Lands Act* of the Province of Alberta on the 11th day of October, 1952;

And whereas the said Mennonite Conference of Alberta operates The Menno Bible Institute at near Didsbury, Alberta, for the sole purpose of nurturing and encouraging intensive Bible study and for training and preparing Bible workers for foreign, home and inter-mission fields;

And whereas a petition presented by the said Mennonite Conference of Alberta prays that an Act be passed by the Legislature of the Province to enact as hereinafter set forth; with regard to the exemption from taxation of that part of the Association's property used by it in the operation of the said Menno Bible Institute;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Exemption from taxation

1. That all the real and personal property described as and situate on:

That portion of the north-east quarter of section 32, in township 30, range 28, west of the fourth meridian in the Province of Alberta described as follows:

Commencing at the north-west corner of the said quarter section, thence easterly along the north boundary thereof 363 feet, thence southerly parallel with the west boundary thereof 240 feet, thence westerly parallel with the said north boundary 363 feet, more or less, to a point on the said west boundary, thence northerly along said west boundary 240 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement, containing 2 acres, more or less,

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals; while used for school, educational, and religious purposes

shall as from the first day of January, 1956, be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind, save and except special frontage assessment taxes under *The Town and Village Act*, 1952.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is  $\frac{\text{Coming}}{\text{into force}}$  assented to.
