An Act to amend An Ordinance to Incorporate
Alberta College

WHEREAS Alberta College was incorporated by *An Ordinance to incorporate Alberta College*, being chapter 25 of the Ordinances of the North-West Territories, 1904; and

Preamble

Whereas the said Alberta College has presented a petition for the amendment as hereinafter set forth of the said *An Act to incorporate Alberta College*, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *An Ordinance to incorporate Alberta College*, being chapter 25 of the Ordinances of the North-West Territories, 1904, is hereby amended.

2. The following is added immediately after section 6:

New
section 6a

"6a. As, from and after the thirty-first day of December, 1954, all the real and personal property owned by the said corporation is exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments, so long as the said real and personal property is being used for school and educational purposes, or any of such purposes, save and except special frontage assessment taxes."
