Explanatory Note

2. Section 1 presently reads as follows:

"1. David J. Young, Frank Macbeth, James H. Woods, David S. Moffat, Charles W. Hague, Allan M. McMahon, Edgar H. Telfer, and such other persons as are now or shall hereafter become members of the corporation to be hereby incorporated shall be and are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by and under the name of the Calgary Golf and Country Club, and by that name shall have perpetual succession and a common seal and shall have power from time to time and at all times hereafter, to purchase, acquire, hold, possess, lease and enjoy for them and their successors for the use and benefit of said corporation all lands, tenements, hereditaments and real and moveable property and estate situate whether within or without the limits of the City of Calgary, and the same to sell, alienate, exchange, lease and otherwise dispose of or encumber whensoever the said corporation shall deem it proper so to do and by the same name shall and may be enabled to sue and to be sued, to plead and to be impleaded, to answer and to be answered unto in any matter or cause whatsoever; provided always that the actual value of such real estate so held as aforesaid shall not at any one time exceed the sum of \$150,000."

An Act to amend the Calgary Golf and Country Club Act

(Assented to _____, 1957)

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying for the amendment of *An Act to Incorporate the Calgary Golf and Country Club*, being chapter 36 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1910 (Second Session), as therein set forth, and it is expedient to grant their prayer:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Calgary Golf and Country Club Act Amendment Act, 1957*". Short title

2. *The Calgary Golf and Country Club Act*, being chapter 36 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1910 (Second Session) is amended as to section 1 by striking out the words and figures "provided always that the actual value of such real estate so held as aforesaid shall not at any one time exceed the sum of \$150,000.00". Section 1 amended

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to. Coming into force
