Explanatory Note

2. (a) "Gas" is not presently defined in this Act though section 2, clause (a) defines "gas equipment" and refers to "liquefied petroleum gas". "Gas equipment" is redefined by removing the reference to a particular gas.

Clause (a) presently reads:

"(a) "gas equipment" includes machinery, equipment, appliances and devices of every kind and description, used or intended to be used in the transmission, distribution, supply, or use of gas including liquefied petroleum gas, in the Province;"

(b) "gas installation" is redefined and given an extended meaning to cover trailers and vehicles, and mobile buildings, where previously it extended only to installations from a meter or regulator upon land, buildings or premises to the place where it was used.

Section 2 clause (c) subclause (i) presently reads:

"(c) "gas installation"

"(i) means the installation of any system of gas piping in or upon any land, building or premises from the meter or regulator where gas is delivered up to the point or points where such gas can be consumed or used by any gas consuming equipment, and".

3. New. Sets out the powers of an inspector in certain cases of danger to life or property from gas installations.

4. Coming into force.

An Act to amend The Gas Protection Act

(Assented to _____, 1957)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Gas Protection Act*, being chapter 129 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended

(a) by striking out clause (a) and by substituting the following:

“(a) “gas” means natural or manufactured gas, liquefied petroleum gas or any mixtures of such gases;

“(a1) “gas equipment” includes machinery, equipment, appliances and devices of every kind and description and used or intended to be used in the transmission, distribution, supply or use of gas;”;

(b) by striking out subclause (i) of clause (c) and by substituting the following:

“(i) means the installation of gas piping and equipment in or upon any land or premises, or mobile or fixed buildings or any vehicles, for the utilization of gas as a fuel for heating, power or lighting, otherwise than in an industrial or manufacturing process, and”.

3. Section 10 is amended

(a) by renumbering the present section as subsection (1),

(b) by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following new subsections:

“(2) If an inspector finds a gas installation that is dangerous to life or property he may disconnect the gas supply thereto or require the person supplying the gas to disconnect the gas supply.

“(3) Where the gas supply has been disconnected pursuant to subsection (2), no person shall reconnect the supply to such gas installation until authorized by the inspector to do so.”.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
