Explanatory Note

2. Subsection (5) presently reads:

“(5) Notwithstanding the provisions of The Tax Recovery Act, a lien filed in respect of land or an interest in land under this Act continues to be an encumbrance against that land registered in the name of a subsequent owner or owners to the same extent as if proceedings had not been taken under The Tax Recovery Act.”

3. Amendment will come into force with the Revision it amends.

An Act to amend The Rural Electrification Revolving

(Assented to _____, 1957)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *The Rural Electrification Revolving Fund Act*, being
chapter 291 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is
hereby amended.

2. Section 17, subsection (5) is amended by adding im-
mediately after the words "*The Tax Recovery Act*" wher-
ever they occur, the words "or *The Irrigation Districts Act*,
as the case may be".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which
the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
