## Explanatory Note

**2. Subsection (4), clause (b) reads:**

“(4) Where a juvenile delinquent is the child .....

“(b) of a parent or legal guardian in receipt of indigent relief under  
The Town and Village Act, The Municipal District Act, or The  
Improvement Districts Act,

then notwithstanding any other provision of this section the child shall  
be deemed to reside in the municipality liable for payment of any part  
of such allowance or such relief.”

This provision is being made to apply also to cities.

An Act to amend The Juvenile Court Act

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Juvenile Court Act*, being chapter 166 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 27, subsection (4), clause (b) is amended by adding immediately after the word "under" the words "*The City Act*,"
- 3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
