A Bill to amend The Public Health Act

#### **Explanatory Note**

2. Section 7 subsection (1) lists various matters about which the Board of Health may issue orders, rules and regulations for the prevention, mitigation and supression of disease. Clause (k1) is related to the clauses dealing with human remains. At present, these only cover undertakers and embalmers, mausoleums and cemeteries.

The new clause (aa1) is intended to provide for the control of a new danger to public health.

3. Section 34 reads as follows:

"34. The Minister may pay to the council of a city having a population in excess of fifty thousand a grant to assist it to provide public health services for its residents."

This amendment is intended to make this assistance available to more communities.

### An Act amend The Public Health Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Public Health Act, being chapter 255 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
  - **2.** Section 7, subsection (1) is amended:
    - (a) by adding immediately after clause (k) the following new clause:
      - "(k1) the location, construction, maintenance and operations of crematoria, and the disposal of unclaimed ashes,",
    - (b) by adding immediately after clause (aa) the following new clause:
    - "(aa1) the control of radiation hazards,".
- **3.** Section 34 is amended by striking out the word "fifty" and by substituting the word "thirty".
- 4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
