Explanatory Note

2. Section 3, subsection (2) clause (a) presently reads:

"(2) A person is eligible for an allowance under this Act

"(a) who is

"(i) awarded a pension under the Old Age Security Act (Canada) or an allowance under the Blind Persons Act (Canada), or

"(ii) awarded assistance under the Old Age Assistance Act (Canada),"

This amendment is made to remove the word "(Canada)" after The Blind Persons Act, and the Old Age Assistance Act, and to improve the wording of the subsection. The Blind Persons Act and the Old Age Assistance Act intended here are that of Alberta and not those of Canada.

3. Section 4 presently reads as follows:

"4. The Minister, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may enter into an agreement with the Government of any other province in Canada that

"(a) pays an allowance of the nature authorized by this Act, and

"(b) has agreed to and does pay the allowance to persons who are residents of that province and who have moved to the Province of Alberta,

providing for the payment to Alberta residents who move to such other province, of a monthly allowance equivalent to what they would be entitled to if they were receiving pensions under the Old Age Pensions Act (Canada) or pensions under the Old Age Security Act (Canada), or allowances under the Blind Persons Act (Canada), or assistance under the Old Age Assistance Act (Canada) from such other province."

An Act to amend The Supplementary Allowances Act

(Assented to _____, 1957)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Supplementary Allowances Act*, being chapter 326 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3, subsection (2) is amended by striking out clause (a) and by substituting the following:

“(a) who is awarded a pension, assistance or an allowance under

“(i) the *Old Age Security Act* (Canada),

“(ii) *The Old Age Assistance Act*, or

“(iii) *The Blind Persons Act*,”

3. Section 4 is amended by striking out the words “if they were receiving pensions under the *Old Age Pensions Act* (Canada) or pensions under the *Old Age Security Act* (Canada), or allowances under the *Blind Persons Act* (Canada), or assistance under the *Old Age Assistance Act* (Canada), from such other province” and by substituting the words “had they remained in Alberta”.

4. This Act comes into force on the day the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
