A Bill to amend The Amusements Act

Explanatory Note

2. Because of the tax change being made by clause 3 of this Bill, many of the places of amusement to which this Act relates will not be remitting a tax for every week and it is therefore no longer necessary to require regular Monday returns.

Section 12 now reads:

"12. (1) On every Monday the owner of every amusement or place of amusement in a city shall make a return to the Minister in the form of a statutory declaration showing the prices of admission to and daily attendance at the place of amusement during the previous week, together with such other information and in such form as the Minister may require.

"(2) The owner of every amusement or place of amusement other than in a city shall make such returns to the Minister and such remittances of the tax collected, at such times and in such manner as may be prescribed by the regulations."

3. This amendment removes all the taxes payable where the price of admission is sixty cents or less.

Paragraph 1 of the Schedule, where relevant, reads:

"1. (a) the amusement tax payable on the price of admission to a place of amusement

"(i) shall be nil where the price of admission is not more than thirty-five cents,

"(ii) shall be three cents where the price of admission is more than thirty-five cents but not more than thirty-seven cents,

"(iii) (Repealed, 1956, c. 5, s. 4)

"(iv) shall be four cents where the price of admission is more than thirty-seven cents but not more than forty-four cents,

"(v) shall be five cents where the price of admission is more than forty-four cents but not more than fifty-five cents,

"(vi) shall be six cents where the price of admission is more than fifty-five cents but not more than sixty-four cents,"

Subparagraph (b) was repealed by 1956, c. 5, s. 4.

An Act to amend The Amusements Act

(Assented to _____, 1957)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Amusements Act*, being chapter 13 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. Section 12 is struck out and the following is substituted:

"12. (1) The owner of every amusement or place of amusement shall make a return to the Minister in the form of a statutory declaration showing the prices of admission to and daily attendance at the place of amusement during any week in which amusement tax was payable at the place of amusement, together with such other information and in such form as the Minister may require.

"(2) The return required under this section shall be forwarded not later than the Monday following the week in which the tax was payable."

3. The Schedule is amended as to paragraph 1.

(a) by striking out the letter "(a)" after the paragraph number,

(b) by striking out subclauses (i), (ii), (iv), (v) and (vi) and by substituting the following:

"(i) shall be nil where the price of admission is not more than sixty cents,

"(ii) shall be six cents where the price of admission is more than sixty cents but not more than sixty-four cents,".

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
