A Bill to amend The Domestic Animals (Municipalities)

### **Explanatory Note**

2. This amendment is for the purpose of removing the requirement that a proposed by-law for the prohibiting of animals running at large be approved by the Department of Municipal Affairs.

Section 22 reads:

"22. Two certified copies of each proposed by-law shall be forwarded by the clerk or treasurer to the Department of Municipal Affairs and the approval of the Department shall be obtained before the by-law is advertised or voted on."

- HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
- **1.** The Domestic Animals (Municipalities) Act, being chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 22 is struck out and the following is substituted:
- "22. A copy of each proposed by-law certified by the clerk of the municipality shall be forwarded by the clerk or treasurer of the municipality to the Department of Municipal Affairs.".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
