Explanatory Note

2. Section 2, clause (i) presently reads:

“(i) “land” means the ground or soil and everything annexed to it by nature or lying in or under the soil, except mines and minerals, whether precious or base, belonging to the Crown;”.

Under Part VI of the Act, drainage district boards have the power in certain cases to expropriate “land”. As the Act presently reads, this includes mines and minerals. The amendment is intended to prevent boards from expropriating mines and minerals.

An Act to amend The Drainage Districts Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Drainage Districts Act*, being chapter 91 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 2, clause (i) is amended by striking out the words "whether precious or base, belonging to the Crown".
- 3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force.
