Explanatory Note

2. Alberta Medical Services, as incorporated by chapter 88 of 1948, does not have the power to enter into reciprocal arrangements with similar bodies elsewhere. This amendment will give them that power.

3. This clause gives the Act a short title by which, in future, it may be the more easily referred to.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. *An Act to Incorporate Medical Services (Alberta) Incorporated*, being chapter 88 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948, is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended

- (a) by relettering the present clause (f) as clause (g),
- (b) by adding immediately after clause (e) the following:

“(f) to enter into reciprocal arrangements with any similar association or body operating in any other province or territory of Canada or in any of the United States of America or in any other country, for the purpose of providing in the respective territory of either party adequate medical, surgical and obstetrical care to the persons covered by contract with either party.”.

3. The following new section is added immediately after section 13:

“**13a.** This Act may be cited as “*The Medical Services (Alberta) Incorporated Act.*”.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
