A Bill to amend The Public Service Act

Explanatory Note

2. This amendment will include within Division 1 of the Public Service, the chairman of the recently created Securities Commission. It will also empower the Lieutenant Governor in Council to designate offices in the Public Service as being in Division 1 to remove the need of amending the Act to mention specific offices in this classification. Clause (a), subsection (1) of section 6 presently reads:

 $\mbox{\ensuremath{^{\prime\prime}}6.}$ (1) The Public Service is divided into two main divisions, as follows:

"(a) Division 1, which shall consist of the Deputy Ministers, the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly, the Legislative Counsel, the Clerk of the Executive Council, the Chairman of the Public Service Commission, the Director of Personnel, the Provincial Auditor, the members of the Board of Public Utility Commissioners, the members of the Provincial Board of Health, the members of the Workmen's Compensation Board, the members of the Alberta Liquor Control Board, the members of the Alberta Power Commission, the Co-ordinator of Civil Defence, the Chairman of the Provincial Marketing Board, the Superintendent of Treasury Branches, the Special Counsel for Alberta at Ottawa, the Chairman of the Board of Industrial Relations and the Agent-General for Alberta at London, England;".

- HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
- 1. The Public Service Act, being chapter 263 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 6, subsection (1), clause (a) is amended by striking out the words "and the Agent-General for Alberta at London, England;" and by substituting the words ", the chairman of the Alberta Securities Commission, the Agent-General for Alberta at London, England and such other offices as may from time to time be designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council as being in Division 1 of the Public Service.".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of April, 1957.
