HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Temporary Restriction on Alienation of Mines and Minerals Act, being chapter 67 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby continued in force until the first day of July, 1958, upon which date the said Act shall expire.
- 2. Chapter 55 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, is hereby repealed.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
