Explanatory Note

2. Section 3 presently reads as follows:

"3. The Minister may provide for the payment of a pension not exceeding the sum of forty dollars a month to a disabled person

"(a) who at the date of the proposed commencement of payment to him

"(i) has attained the age of eighteen years, and

"(ii) has resided in Alberta continuously for at least the five years immediately preceding the proposed commencement date of payments to him and for an aggregate period of at least ten years,

"(b) who is not

"(i) for the purposes of health and welfare services the responsibility of the Government of Canada, or

"(ii) in receipt of

"(A) assistance under The Old Age Assistance Act,

"(B) an allowance under The Blind Persons Act,

"(C) a pension under the Old Age Security Act (Canada),

"(D) an allowance under The Mothers' Allowance Act,

"(E) a pension under The Widows' Pensions Act, or

"(F) an allowance under the Disabled Persons Act (Canada), and

"(c) who is

"(i) unmarried and his income, inclusive of the pension, is not more than seven hundred and twenty dollars a year, or

"(ii) married and living with his spouse and the total income, inclusive of the pension, of the recipient and his spouse is not more than twelve hundred dollars a year."

3. Section 4 reads in part:

"4. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations for carrying the purposes and provisions of this Act into effect, and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, may make regulations providing for"

This provision replaces clause (c) of section 3.

An Act to amend The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act

(Assented to _____, 1957)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act*, being chapter 86 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended

- (a) by striking out the word "forty" and by substituting the word "forty-six",
- (b) by adding immediately at the end of clause (a) the word "and",
- (c) as to clause (b)
 - (i) by striking out paragraph (D) of subclause (ii),
 - (ii) by striking out the word "and" at the end of paragraph (F),
- (d) by striking out clause (c).

3. Section 4 is amended

- (a) by striking out the word "and" at the end of clause (f),
- (b) by adding immediately at the end of clause (g) the word "and",
- (c) by adding immediately after clause (g) the following clause:
 - "(h) the test of financial means with which each applicant for an allowance must comply."

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, come into force and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times on and after the first day of July, 1957.
