Explanatory Note

2. The Emergency Teacher Training Act is a temporary Act and expires on July 1, 1958, unless renewed as provided in section 10. The Act is not being continued in force and this Bill sets forth a winding-up provision enabling students who started their studies prior to August 1, 1957, to complete the training program under the Act.

An Act to amend The Emergency Teacher Training Act

(Assented to _____, 1958)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Emergency Teacher Training Act*, being chapter 100 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. The following new section is added following section 10:

“**11.** Notwithstanding section 10 this Act shall continue in force on and after the first day of July, 1958, to the extent that is necessary for the sole purpose of enabling student-teachers who began their training under the emergency training program before the first day of August, 1957, and no others, to continue and complete their training as provided by sections 2 to 9 of this Act.”.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
