Explanatory Note

2. This proposed new section is similar to ones found in many other Acts under which licences are issued and will make a certificate of the Deputy Attorney General receivable in evidence as *prima facie* proof that a person does or does not hold a licence under the Act.

An Act to amend The Private Detectives Act

(Assented to _____, 1958)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Private Detectives Act*, being chapter 240 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. The following section is added immediately after section 23:

"24. Where proof of the licensing or non-licensing of a person under this Act is required, the production of a certificate purporting to be under the hand of the Deputy Minister to the effect that the person named therein was or was not licensed as a private detective or as a private detective's agent is *prima facie* proof thereof, without proof of signature or official character."

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
