Explanatory Note

2. Section 17 (1) reads: "For the purposes of this section, "elector" means a person entitled to vote on a money by-law in the municipality." That is, "elector" has in section 17, which makes provision for the establishment of public municipal libraries, the meaning of proprietary elector. However the term occurs in sections 19(1)(b), 19(2)(b), 29(2), 29(3) and 31 of this Part, and by implication means in these sections general electors. Since the electors are required to vote on what amounts to money by-laws, this amendment will make it clear that proprietary electors are intended where the term "elector" is used in this Part.

- 1. The Libraries Act, being chapter 27 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 17, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the word "section" and by substituting the word "Part".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
