A Bill to amend The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act

Explanatory Note

General. The purpose of this amendment is twofold: (1) to increase the pension from \$46.00 per month to \$55.00 per month; (2) to change the resident requirements for the pension. This Act is wholly the provincial disabled pensions plan and there are no contributions from the Government of Canada thereto.

2. Section 3, as relevant, reads as follows:

"3. The Minister may provide for the payment of a pension not exceeding the sum of forty-six dollars a month to a disabled person

"(a) who at the date of the proposed commencement of payment to him

"(i) has attained the age of eighteen years, and

"(ii) has resided in Alberta for the ten years immediately preceding the date on which the application for a pension is made,".

An Act to amend The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act

(Assented to _____, 1958)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Disabled Persons' Pensions Act*, being chapter 86 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955 is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended

(a) by striking out the word "forty-six" and by substituting the word "fifty-five",

(b) as to clause (a) by striking out subclause (ii) and by substituting the following:

"(ii) has resided in Alberta for both

"(A) the ten years immediately preceding the date on which the application for a pension is made or, if he has not so resided, had been in Alberta before the immediately preceding ten years for an aggregate period equal to or greater than twice the aggregate period of absences from Alberta during the immediately preceding ten years, and

"(B) the greater part of the ten hundred and ninety-five days immediately preceding the date on which the application for pension is made,".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
