A Bill to amend The Assessment Duties Temporary Suspension Act

## **Explanatory Note**

General. In 1957 the Legislature enacted The Municipalities Assessment and Equalization Act and The Assessment Appeal Board Act. As a result of the changes made by these Acts and for greater adminstrative efficiency, it is proposed to abolish the position of Director of Assessments and to divide his duties between a Supervisor of Assessments and an Assessment Commissioner.

- ${\bf 3.}$  Definition of "Supervisor" substituted for definition of "Director".
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{4.}}$  Certain duties formerly exercised by the Director to be exercised by the Supervisor.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Assessment Duties Temporary Suspension Act, being chapter 7 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1956, is hereby amended.
- **2.** The long title is amended by striking out the word "Director" and by substituting the word "Supervisor".
- **3.** Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (a) and by substituting the following:
  - "(a) "Supervisor" means the Supervisor of Assessments appointed pursuant to The Municipalities Assessment and Equalization Act;".
- **4.** Section 3 is amended by striking out the word "Director" and by substituting the word "Supervisor".
- **5.** Section 4 is amended by striking out the word "Director" and by substituting the word "Supervisor".
- 6. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
