Explanatory Note

2. The purpose of this amendment is to extend the definition of "fuel oil" in this Act to include liquefied petroleum gas, as defined, so that the Act will bring within its scope all dealers in fuel oil as that term is defined at the present time under The Fuel Oil Tax Act.

Section 2(a) presently reads:

"2. In this Act,

"(a) "fuel oil"

"(i) means a liquid that is capable of being used for the generation of power in an internal combustion engine, and

"(ii) includes, without derogating from the generality of the foregoing,

"(A) all liquid products obtained, whether by distillation or condensation or absorption or any other process, from petroleum, natural gas, casing head or natural gasoline, benzol, benzine, naphtha, coal, coal tar, bituminous sands, oil shales, kerosene, gas oil and any combination of any such products, and prepared, advertised, offered for sale, sold for use as or used for or capable of being used for the generation of power in an internal combustion engine, and

"(B) a product obtained by blending any such liquid product with another product if the resultant product so obtained is capable of use for the generation of power in an internal combustion engine;"

An Act to amend The Fuel Oil Licensing Act

(Assented to , 1958)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Fuel Oil Licensing Act, being chapter 124 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended

(a) as to clause (a)

(i) by striking out the word "and" where it occurs at the end of subclause (i),

(ii) by renumbering subclause (ii) as subclause (iii),

(iii) by adding immediately after subclause (i) the following subclause:

"(ii) includes liquefied petroleum gas, and",

(b) by relettering clauses (b) and (c) as clauses (c) and (d),

(c) by adding immediately after clause (a) the following clause:

"(b) "liquefied petroleum gas" includes any matter or substance that is composed predominantly of any of the following hydrocarbons or mixtures of them, namely, propane, propylene, butane (normal or iso-butane) or butylene;"

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
