Explanatory Note

2. This proposed amendment will broaden the definition of "seed dealer" to provide a measure of control over dealer practices which involve contracts or agreements to purchase. Under section \$, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations requiring seed dealers or any specified class of seed dealers to be licensed.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Seed Dealers Act, being chapter 87 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1957, is hereby amended.
- **2.** Section 2 is amended by striking out clause (c) and by substituting the following:
 - "(c) "seed dealer" means any person, partnership, corporation, co-operative association or seed marketing or shipping organization dealing or offering to deal in seed in Alberta, whether directly or through agents, with producers but does not include a farmer, rancher or person buying seed for his own use or a producer selling seed produced by himself;".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
