A Bill to amend The School Grants Act

HON. MR. AALBORG

Explanatory Note

2.The School Grants Act authorizes the Minister of Education with Lieutenant Governor in Council's approval, to make regulations for the apportionment and distribution of all money appropriated for the purpose of making grants toward elementary and secondary education. Section 4 (g) refers to colleges under section 178 (3) of The School Act. That provision will be replaced by The Public Junior Colleges Act, and the reference is therefore changed.

Section 4 (g) reads at present:

"4. The regulations may provide for the payment of grants for the purpose of or to assist in carrying out any or all of the following purposes:

"(g) the operation of a college pursuant to subsection (3) of section 178 of The School Act."

An Act to amend The School Grants Act

(Assented to _____, 1958)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The School Grants Act*, being chapter 299 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. Section 4 is amended by striking out clause (*g*) and by substituting the following:

“(*g*) the operation of a junior college pursuant to *The Public Junior Colleges Act*.”.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
