HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Police Act, being chapter 236 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
 - 2. Section 20 is amended
 - (a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1),
 - (b) by adding immediately after the renumbered subsection (1) the following new subsection:
 - "(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) a constable appointed by a city may act outside the boundaries of the city in the execution of his duties as a city constable and for such purposes has, within the Province, all the powers of a provincial constable.".
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
