A Bill to amend The Queen's Printer Act

Explanatory Note

2. Section 8, subsection (2) presently reads:

“(2) The Provincial Treasurer may, on a requisition of the Queen's Printer, advance out of the General Revenue Fund such sums of money as are required to pay for the stationery, office supplies, printing or bindery work, referred to in subsection (1), but the net amount of such advances shall not at any time exceed the sum of two hundred thousand dollars.”.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** *The Queen's Printer Act*, being chapter 275 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.
- 2.** Section 8, subsection (2) is amended by striking out the word "two" and by substituting the word "three".
- 3.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
