H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Amusements Act, being chapter 13 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, is hereby amended.

2. The following new section is added immediately after section 18:

"18a. No person shall

- "(a) supply to any person a nitrate base film that is capable of being used in a moving picture machine, or
- "(b) use a nitrate base film in a moving picture machine in any place of amusement or other place in the Province.".
