A Bill to amend The Magistrates and Justices Act

Explanatory Note

At the present time the books, documents and papers of magistrates and justices are kept for 10 years before destruction may be ordered under section 4 of The Preservation of Public Documents Act (R.S.A. 1955, chapter 254). This amendment will enable another rule to be provided in respect of these documents, books and papers.

An Act to amend The Magistrates and Justices Act

(Assented to _____, 1959)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Magistrates and Justices Act*, being chapter 186 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by adding immediately after section 15 the following section:

16. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations providing for the safe-keeping, inspection and destruction of books, documents and papers of magistrates and justices.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
