Explanatory Note

With respect to all provincial lands that are held, used or occupied for public works, subsection (2) of section 6 of The Public Works Department Act provides:

 $^{\prime\prime}(2)$ The Department may dispose of such lands with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council and under the hand and official seal of the Minister."

An official seal, or seal of office for a Department or Minister is prescribed by only two statutes, viz., The Agent-General Act (R.S.A. 1955, chapter 3, section 2) for the Agent-General for Alberta in the United Kingdom and The Treasury Department Act (R.S.A. 1955, chapter 343, section 3(2)) for the Treasury Department. As there is no official seal prescribed by legislation for the Minister of Public Works, the reference thereto in this Act is being removed.

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Section 6, subsection (2) of *The Public Works Department Act*, being chapter 270 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by striking out the words "and official seal".

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
